A few weeks before theICA Congress in Seoul we will make the nine nominated films available on this website. At that time everyone is invited to view the nine films and cast your vote for The People's award. The People's award will also be announced at the ICA Congress.

It has been such a joyful and inspiring journey so far and we can't wait to show you all the great films!

Our goal is to make all entries available on the ICA SPA website sometime after the ICA Seoul Congress.
